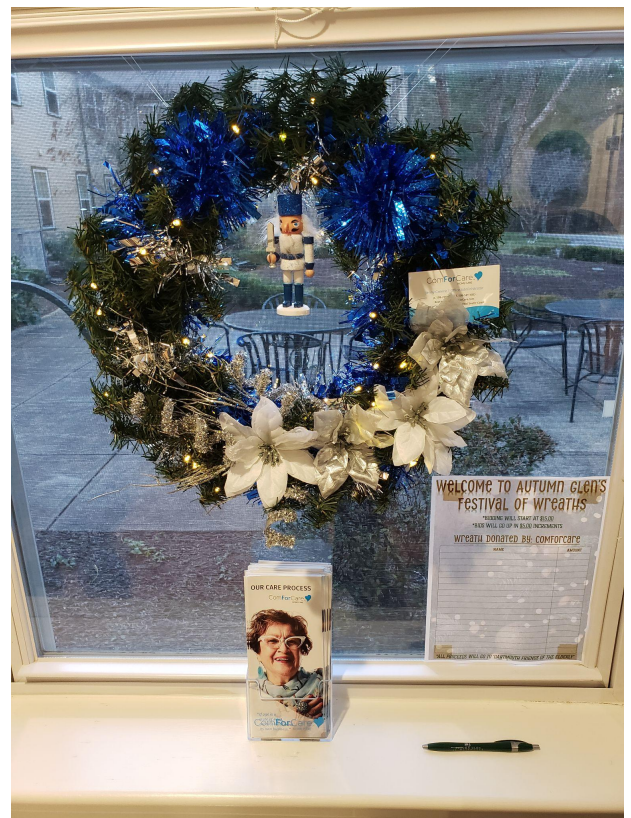
Our wreath is featured over on the bottom right. Put together by our Office Manager Jenny Greene decorated it in the classic ComForCare blue and white.
