

FALL MONITORING & DETECTION



Falls can happen anytime, anywhere. When they happen, it is important that if needed, help can come right away. With an estimated 684,000 fatal falls occurring each year, the World Health Organization recognizes falls as the second leading cause of unintentional injury death for adults 65 and older. Further, lying on the floor for an extended period of time

following a fall can increase the risk of health decline and even death. Falls are a public health concern which requires solutions to quickly identify if a fall has occurred in the home.

Solution

Our real-time fall detection provides quick escalation and response times which can prevent or reduce exacerbation of injuries.


Non-intrusive sensors are placed throughout the home to continually scan a room for movement using 4G wave technology, without the need for cameras or wearable devices. When a fall is detected, the sensor is triggered and prompt follow-up care is provided. Proactive weekly calls are used to review activity with the older adult or family and solutions are suggested to help identify and reduce fall risks.

Benefit

This non-invasive technology allows for quicker responses by allowing us to be more proactive as needs change, averting a decline in health. Further, the real-time response allows for quick intervention—without having to worry if a phone is nearby or having to press a button to summon help. The benefit of this approach allows individuals to safely age in place, knowing the technology is always working.
